CIRCULAR

All the scientists are requested to **strictly instruct the students, research fellows and lab assistants** working in their lab to follow the following instructions while disposing the lab wastes.

- Each lab should have two designated separate closed containers for collecting decomposable and non-decomposable wastes (plastic wares including tips, tubes etc)
- Each research /technical staff should be instructed to place the waste in the designated waste bins only (no mixing of decomposable and non-decomposable wastes)
- Each lab should make arrangements to collect the non-decomposable wastes in the gunny bag (to be arranged at lab level) and to keepat the designated place near lower car parking area for disposal by the Corporation staff
- Decontaminated ethidium bromide gels should be put separately in the designated pit (location of the pit will be informed later)
