The Swachhta Hi Seva programme on 21.09.2018 was observed at ICAR-IISR headquarters by organizing waste collection drive in households, shared places and creating awareness on disposal of waste through eco-friendly approaches to the residents of Hill View residential area, Moozhikkal, Kozhikode. The programme was inaugurated by Smt. P. K. Shalini, Councilor, Kozhikode Corporation during which she expressed deep gratitude and willingness of the local government body to join hands with the institute to extend similar kind of activities in future. Dr. C. K. Thankamani, Principal Scientist and Nodal Officer, Swachhta Mission of the Institute handled a training session on disposal of degradable wastes through composting which was followed by a demonstration of different methods of composting using earthen pots and through pits. To spread the message of clean environment and to highlight the significance of Swach Bharat Mission, a contingent of volunteers representing ICAR - IISR also joined the programme.



At ICAR - Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Peruvannamuzhi, the office premises and rooms were cleaned during which, weeds and plastic wastes were removed. An awareness programme was also organized during the occasion in which more than 50 farmers participated.
