The Swachhta Hi Seva campaign on 28.09.2018 was observed at ICAR-IISR headquarters by organizing a follow-up programme on composting at Hill View residential area, Moozhikkal, Kozhikode. Dr. C. K. Thankamani, Principal Scientist and Nodal Officer (Swachhta Mission, ICAR-IISR) explained the different methods of composting which was followed by demonstration on compost pit preparation in which the residents and volunteers of the institute participated.
